



RAY CURRY AND CHUCK BROWNING SUPPORT UAW DEFENSE WORKERS!

Ray (US Army and Army Reserves) and Chuck (US Air Force) are veterans who support UAW members in the defense industry.

Check out their track record:

- **Honeywell: UAW Local 9 (South Bend, IN):** eliminated tier system and brought everyone to top tier status.
- **Oshkosh Defense: UAW Local 578 (Oshkosh, WI):** led public campaign for USPS to build next generation electric postal vehicles in Oshkosh including filing lawsuit, building coalitions with environmental groups and enlisting support from elected officials.
- **Electric Boat: UAW Local 571 (Groton, CT):** helped secure \$5.1 billion contract for modification for the Columbia-class ballistic-missile submarine program.
- **Bath Iron Works: UAW Local 3999 (Bath, Maine):** fighting to keep the 2 ship per year procurement of the US Navy on track which provides job security to UAW members who design and engineer destroyers.
- **Bell Helicopter and Rolls-Royce: UAW Local 218 (Grand Prairie, TX) and UAW Local 933 (Indianapolis, IN):** helped secure support for UAW members to make replacement Black Hawk helicopter for US Army. Deal could reach \$70 billion and expected to provide job stability and growth for next thirty years.
- **Lockheed Martin: UAW Local 788 (Orlando, FL), UAW Local 1821 (Ocala, FL), UAW Local 1921 (New Orleans, LA) and UAW Local 848 (Grand Prairie, TX):** helped secure multiple contracts that benefit UAW members including F-35 contract worth \$7.6 billion, \$95 million contract for modernization of target sight systems and pilot night vision systems, \$225 million contract for Sniper Comprehensive Targeting Pods, Missiles and Fire controls for M299 missile, launchers for Hellfire and JAGM missiles, Missiles and Fire Controls Dallas (\$1.42 billion) to build THAAD (Terminal High Altitude Area Defense) interceptors, six Orion spacecraft for NASA (totaling \$4.6 billion) with option for six more.
- **Aerojet Rocketdyne: UAW Local 887 (Palmdale, CA):** helped secure contract for rockets that will carry the Artemis program into space. NASA has recently placed a \$1.79 billion order for an additional 18 rocket engines. The Artemis Moon Mission will land the first woman and first person of color on the moon.
